Witnesseth That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred & Twenty Eight (\$128.00) Dollars, to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit: Lot 1164 One hundred Sixty four in block 1541 Fifty four in that portion of the City of Lawrence, known as West Lawrence, and according to the plat of said City with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.
