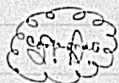


At the request of A. H. Muter and in consideration of the payment of the debt named therein, the Lombard Investment Company does hereby release the Mortgage for \$1100.00. Eleven hundred and no. Dollars, bearing date the 17th day of August 1886, made by Adam Suttle and Harriet his wife to the Lombard Investment Company, on the following described property: South half (1/2) of the Northwest quarter (1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), in Township Fourteen (14) of Range Eighteen (18), and the South half (1/2) of the Northeast quarter (1/4) of Section Fourteen Township Fourteen (14), Range Eighteen (18). Except 2 1/4 % Acres described as follows: To wit, Commencing 87 % chains East of the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter (1/4) of Section Fourteen (14) Township Fourteen (14), of Range Eighteen (18), thence North 70 degrees (70) East 10 % chains to a stone, thence South 51 1/4 degrees East 4 % chains along the centre of County Road; thence South 35 1/4 degrees East 6 % chains to angle stake, thence South 54 1/2 degrees East 4 chains to angle stake, thence South 77 degrees East 8 chains to angle stake, thence South 55 degrees East 8 % chains to stone in centre of road at a point 1 1/3 % chains West of quarter (1/4) Section corner on the East of Section Fourteen (14) Township Fourteen (14) of Range Eighteen (18), thence West on South line of Northeast quarter of Section Fourteen (14), Thirty and 1/2 % chains to the place of beginning, which is recorded in Book 13 of Real Estate Mortgages, Page 349 of the records of Douglas County, Kansas, on the 21st day of August 1886 at 2 o'clock P.M.
