

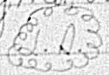

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged has Granted Bargained and Sold, and by these presents does Grant, Bargain, Sell Convey and Confirm unto the said party of the second part, and its successors and assigns forever all the following described tract, piece, or parcel of land lying and situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas to-wit: The Northwest Quarter of Section Eight (8) in Township Twenty eight (28) South of Range Eleven (11) West of the 6th P.M.
