We do hereby apply to the present owner of the promissory note given by William Stover single to E. M. Sheldon for the sum of twelve hundred dollars dated May 2nd 1887 due in five years after the date thereof, and bearing interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest payable at Bank of Gilman and Son Co New York City which said note is secured by a Trust Deed upon real estate situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas (reference being had to said deed, which is recorded in Volume 17 of Mon page 28 of the records of said Douglas County, for a more particular description of said real estate, for an extension of the time of payment of the same, and do hereby agree that if the time for payment of the principal of said note shall be extended for five years from the maturity thereof with the privilege to pay May 2nd 1895 as above stated, by the owner of said note, the interest to remain at the rate of seven per cent per annum payable semi-annually; that none of the other conditions and obligations of said note and the Trust deed securing the same, except as hereinbefore mentioned, shall be affected by such extension but shall remain in full force and virtue, and be binding upon us as well as on the original makers of said note and Trust deed, and we do guarantee that said interest and principal shall be paid promptly as it matures, and we covenant that the legal title to the property described in said deed is now vested in us.
