



This Indenture, made this first day of June in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight
hundred and ninety two between Nelly C. Griffith and her husband Griffith her hus-
band of Kansas City in the County of Wyandotte and State of Kansas, of the first part,
and Wm. N. Rollins trustee of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One Thousand "Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby ac-
knowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to
the said party of the second part his assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land
situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows: with
Lot Number Twenty three (23) on Ohio Street in the City of Lawrence with the appurten-
ances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein.
And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the de-
livery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized
of a good and indefeasible state of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incum-
brances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand
