second part, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, forever, all of the following-described tracts, pieces, or parcels of land, lying and situate in the City of Lawrence, County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: Beginning Nine (9) rods West of the center of the North West quarter of the South West quarter (fractional) of Section No Twenty nine (29) in Township No Twelve (12) of Range No Twenty (20) thence West Eleven (11) rods, thence North thirteen (13) rods six and one half (6 1/2) feet, thence East Eleven (11) rods, thence South thirteen (13) rods six and one half (6 1/2) feet. Also Commencing twenty (20) rods East of said North West corner of said South West quarter of Section No Twenty nine (29) aforesaid and then run South twenty one (21) rods and Seven (7) feet for point of beginning from thence run East Eleven (11) rods, thence South Eighty five (85) feet, thence West Eleven (11) rods, thence North Eighty five (85) feet to the beginning point, all being in that part of the City of Lawrence formerly known as North Lawrence.

To Have and to hold the same, with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and all rights of homestead exemption, unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the second part its successors and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. Provided, always, And this instrument is made, executed and delivered upon the following conditions, to-wit:

First: Said J. P. Lamb and John Lamb are justly indebted unto the said party of the second part in the principal sum of Six hundred Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, being for a loan thereof made by the said party of the second part to the said J. P. Lamb and John Lamb and payable according to the tenor and effect of One certain First Mortgage Real Estate Note and ten coupons executed and delivered by the said J. P. Lamb and John Lamb bearing date July 12th 1892, payable to the order of the said Merchants Loan and Savings Bank five years after date, at the City of Lawrence Kansas with interest thereon from date until maturity at the rate of Eight per cent per annum payable semi-annually on the twelfth days of January and July in each year and percent per annum after maturity, the installments of interest being further evidenced by ten coupons attached to said principal note, and of vendata therewith, and payable to the order of said Merchants Loan and Savings Bank of Lawrence Kansas.

Second: Said parties of the first part hereby agree to pay all taxes and assessments
