For and in consideration of the sum of One $\frac{1}{10}$ Dollar to him in hand paid I hereby sell and convey to Thos D. Jane the following described premises, situated in Douglas County, State of Kansas, to-wit: Lot numbered Nineteen (19) in block numbered thirteen (13) in Jane Place Addition to the City of Lawrence Douglas County Kansas. I do covenant and agree with said mortgagee that I am seized of a fee simple estate in said premises, and that the same is free and clear of incumbrances, and I do further expressly waive all benefits of Homestead provided by Section 9, Article 15 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas or any statute in pursuance thereof.

This conveyance is a mortgage to secure the payment of Two Hundred dollars part purchase money, according to the terms of two certain promissory notes this day executed and delivered by Philip Olmsted to with 8 percent interest per annum from date of August 10, 1892 payable as follows: One in one year, the other in two years and both to the order of T. D. Jane. Said notes being part purchase price of above property.
