This Indenture Made this first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety two between Jackson Graham and Mary J. Graham husband and wife (being of law ful age) of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Wilder J. Metcalf of Lawrence Kansas of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold and do by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part and their heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to wit: The south half of the south half of the North East fractional quarter of Section No six (6) in Township No. Thirteen (13) of Range No Nine (9) with the appurtenances and all the estate, till and interest of the said parties of the first part therein and the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances; that they have good right to sell and convey said premises, and that they will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claim of all persons.

This grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Five hundred Dollars, and interest thereon, according to the terms of a certain mortgage note and two interest notes or coupons, this day executed by the said parties of the first part to wit: Note No. 1, for Five hundred Dollars, due November 1st 1897 and dated November 1st 1892, payable to Russell and Metcalf for order, at the Importers and Traders National Bank of New York City N. Y., with interest payable semi-annually on the first day of May and November in each year, according to coupons attached to said note. The parties of the first part further agree that they will pay all taxes and assessments upon the said premises before they shall become delinquent; and they will keep the building on said property insured for ~~one~~ one thousand dollars in one approved Insurance company, payable in case of loss, to the mortgagee or assigns, and deliver the policy to the mortgagee, as collateral security herefor.

Now, if such payments be made as herein specified, this conveyance shall be void and
