This Indenture, Made this 15th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety two between Eli Wilson and Laura L. Wilson his wife of Grant Township in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and M. J. Lindley of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter (1/4) of Section eleven (11) Township twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) Thence South thirty eight and 3/4 chains Thence East thirteen (13) 3/4 chains Thence North thirty eight 3/4 chains Thence West thirteen 3/4 chains to the place of beginning. Except Eight (8) Acres more or less off the south end of the above described lands which has been heretofore deeded to John L. Wilson also the West 1/2 fractional half (1/2) of Section Number Eleven (11) in Township Number twelve (12) in Range Number Nineteen (19) containing in all fifty three 1/2 Acres more or less, otherwise described as Lots Nos 7-8 & 9 Section Eleven (11) Township twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein had the said Eli Wilson and Laura L. Wilson do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance, therein, free, and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever. This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars, according to the terms of One certain promissory note this day executed by the said Eli Wilson and Laura L. Wilson to the said party of the second part, said note being given for the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars,
