This Indenture, Made this Twenty Fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and Ninety three. Witnesseth, that Alexander Kiser, Mary
Kiser his wife, D. O. Kiser, Ella Kiser his wife, Laura Tarry & Peter Tarry her husband of the
county of Douglas and state of Kansas, party of the first part, for and in consideration
of Eight Hundred Dollars, conveys and warrants to B. B. Power party of the second part,
his heirs and assigns, the real estate hereinafter described, situate in the county of Douglas
and state of Kansas, to-wit: The East Seventy Two (72) acres of the South West Quarter of Section
No Twenty Four (24) Township No Thirteen (13) South of Range No Eighteen (18) East of the Sixth
P. M. L. S. Except Five (5) acres conveyed by Amizi J. Steele to H. L. Hughes August 9, 1871.

To secure the said party of the second part for an actual of money made to the said
B. B. Power as evidenced by a certain Bond for the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars, of even
date herewith, in and by which said bond the party of the first part promise to pay to
the order of B. B. Power in lawful money of the United States of America, the principal
sum of Eight Hundred Dollars five years after date thereof, with interest thereon at
the rate of Nine per centum per annum, interest payable semi-annually, according to
and upon presentation of interest coupons therefor thereunto attached both principal
and interest being payable at the Watkins National Bank of Lawrence, Kansas.

Indenture being payable at the Watkins National Bank of Lawrence, Kansas.
Agreeing, that in case any interest on any of said sums shall remain unpaid for
ten days after the same becomes due, then the entire sum covered by said bond
and secured by this Mortgage Deed, to become immediately due and payable, with-
out any notice of any kind whatsoever, and same to be collected in like manner
as if the full time provided in said bond had expired.

It is hereby expressly agreed that said first party shall insure the building(s) that
are insurable herein, in favor of the party of the second part, against loss or damage
