This Indenture, Made this Sixth day of April in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety Three between Josiah Nicholson & Mattie B. Nicholson his wife of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part and Joseph Lewis of the second part; Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Lot number one hundred and fourteen (114) Vermont Street in the City of Lawrence Douglas County Kansas - with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said Parties of the First Part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances
