Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: All of Block No Seventy nine (79) Block No Eighty (80) Except lots 18 and 20. Block No Eighty one (81) except lot 6 Block No Eighty Eight (88) Except Lot 2. Block No Eighty nine (89) Block No Ninety (90) Block No One hundred and Seventeen (117) Block No One hundred and Eighteen (118) Block No One hundred and nineteen (119) Block No One hundred and twenty seven (127) Block No One hundred and twenty eight (128) and Block No One hundred and fifty two (152) Except lot 20 - all in the City of Eudora in said County and State, in the Vacated portion of said City of Eudora, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.
