Witnesseth, That the said part of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and Twenty five Dollars in hand paid by said part of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he sold and by these presents does grant, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his successors in trust heirs and assigns forever all of the following described Real Estate lying and situate in the County of [unclear] and State of Kansas, to-wit: The undivided one half interest in the South East quarter of Section Seven (7) Township Fourteen (14) Range Twenty (20) East of the [unclear] described as follows, commencing at a point on the West line of said quarter section Twenty five and one half (25 1/2) rods North of the South West corner of said quarter section, thence North along the West line of said quarter section Eighty three (83) rods, thence along North line One hundred and Sixty (160) to East line of said quarter section, thence South Eighty three (83) along east
