S. Govmt Survey.

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas, said Charles M. Baldwin party of the first part has this day executed and delivered one certain promissory note in writing, to said party of the second part, of which the following is a copy in substance
