Dated at Lawrence Kansas this May 15th 1897.

at the North East Corner of the South East Quarter of said Section Ten (10) and running thence West to the Center of Coon Creek, thence down the center of the channel of said Coon Creek to the Wakarusa, thence down the channel of the Wakarusa to the East line of the last aforesaid Quarter Section thence North to the place of beginning, all of said above described premises being in Township Thirteen (13) Range Eighteen (18) East of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian and containing in all Three Hundred and Thirty Two (332) acres, more or less, as security for the payment to said Mortgage of the sum of Twenty Eight Hundred (\$2,800.00) Dollars in the gold coin of the United States of America, with interest thereon and Ten per cent attorneys fee according to the terms of Three certain promissory notes of date May 14th 1894, in the words and figures following to wit:

Lohr at the Merchants National Bank of San Diego Calif. the sum of One Thousand Dollars with interest thereon from this date until payment, at the rate of six per cent. per annum payable semi-annually, and if not so paid, then to become part of the principal of this Note, and to bear like rate of interest till paid. Both principal and interest to be paid in United States gold coin. And I further agree that in the event suit being brought against me then there shall be added to any judgment against me rendered in said suit, as counsel fees, an additional sum of Ten per centum in like gold coin, upon the amount of the principal and interest hereof accrued, at the time of the entry of such judgment; or, if paid before judgment and after action commenced, then on the amount at the date of payment.
