Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred & 20/100 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas to wit: The North East Quarter of Section No Eight (8) in Township No Thirteen (13) South of Range No Eighteen (18) East of the Sixth P.M.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said John Demmeiler has this day executed his certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of which the following is a copy, \$700.00 Lawrence Kansas June 26 1894. On or before June 26 1898 after date I promise to pay to the order of Peter Salverda at the Lawrence National Bank, Seven Hundred Dollars, Value received, with interest at 8 per cent per annum payable annually, John Demmeiler

Said second party also agrees to pay Russell & Micaly a balance of \$100. and interest, on the note of \$1500. given them June 30 1890 by said Peter Salverda.
