Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty Five and $\frac{25}{100}$ Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey, unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in Douglas County, and State of Kansas to-wit: Commencing in the center of public road Nineteen Rods North of the South East corner of the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Fourteen (14) Range Eighteen (18); thence running North Sixty one Rods to North East corner of said South East quarter of said North West quarter Section Eight (8) Township Fourteen (14) Range Eighteen (18); thence West on North line of said South East quarter of said North West quarter Thirty Six Rods, thence South Sixty five and half Rods to center of county road; thence southeasterly along center of said road to place of beginning and containing twelve acres more or less.
