This Indenture, Made this 17 day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety two between Edward Black and Martha Black his wife of the 1st of Eudora in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and E. J. Blair of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and twenty five DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the North line of the North East quarter of Section thirteen Township thirty four Range twenty in the middle of the North East corner of said section line crossing said creek making the North East corner of said land hereby described thence running West on said section line to the middle of the said creek making the North West corner of said land and by described thence following in the middle of said creek in its course through said quarter section to the place of beginning being about four acres of land more or less and otherwise known as all that part of said North East quarter of the North East quarter of the same land on line owned by William Black and dated to said Edward Black on 13th of Dec 11/1902 which deed is recorded in the Register's Office for Douglas County, Kansas in Book 105 and dated 13th of Dec 11/1902 with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said

Parties of the first part

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Five hundred and twenty five Dollars according to the terms of two certain Promissory Notes this day executed and delivered by the said Parties of the first part to the said party of the second part: \$100 & \$200 both payable one year after date to order of party of second part with interest at 10% from date payable semi-annually

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
