This Indenture, Made this 15th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety three, between

William R. Green and Lallie A. Green his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and James N. Mitchell Administrator of the Estate of Susan Hogan deceased of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good considerations DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his executors in interest heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the North line of the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 12, South of Range 20 East where said line crosses the West line of Right of Way of the Lawrence Branch of the Union Pacific Railroad running West along said line $\frac{9}{16}$ ft. Three South $\frac{5}{8}$ East $78\frac{1}{2}$ ft. South $69\frac{1}{4}$ West $87\frac{1}{2}$ ft. Then South $57\frac{1}{2}$ East $34\frac{1}{2}$ ft. line of right of way of said Railroad thence North $69\frac{1}{4}$ East along said line of right of way $105\frac{1}{2}$ ft. thence he descends line along said right of way $111\frac{1}{2}$ ft. Radius $128\frac{1}{2}$ ft. to point of beginning containing $12\frac{23}{32}$ acres more or less variation $8\frac{1}{2}$ ft. East

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therem. And the said William R. Green and Lallie A. Green his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum—~~one~~ unpaid balance of the sum of Eighty Five Hundred Dollars \$850.00 which said sum was evidenced by Thirteen Promissory Notes dated March this day executed and delivered by the according to the terms of 1886 and certain to the said party of the second part: William R. Green a single man, Susan N. Hogan and secured to the said party of the second part: William R. Green and Lallie A. Green his wife their by a certain mortgage executed on the same date by said William R. Green to said Hogan on certain real estate situated in Douglas County Kansas and bought of Susan N. Hogan by said William R. Green

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part ^{his executors in interest} executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part ^{his executors in interest} executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said William R. Green and Lallie A. Green his wife their heirs and assigns.
