This Indenture, Made this 18th day of May in the year of our

Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety three between _____
 _____ Mary E. Hayne (formerly Mary C. Davis) and H. W. Hayne her husband
 of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas
 of the first part, and William D. Sinclair, of same place
 of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of
 Four Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party
 of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State
 of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Lot No one hundred and ninety three (193) and the North
 half of Lot No one hundred and ninety five (195) both on Tennessee Street, in the City
 of Lawrence; being the home tract of operators, who agree to maintain \$500. insurance
 thereon, during existence of this loan, for benefit of second party, his heirs or assigns,

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said
 parties of the first part

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized
 of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances, and that they will warrant
 and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, against all persons lawfully claiming same.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

Four Hundred Dollars

according to the terms of one certain mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the
 said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part;
 due in five (5) years from date, with interest from date to maturity or default, as evidenced by
 coupons attached to said note, and interest after maturity or default until fully paid at
 the rate of ten per cent per annum

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any
 part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute,
 and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his
 executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner
 prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part executors, administrators
 or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with
 the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on
 demand to the said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
