This Indenture, Made this 15th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety three between P. A. Lehus and R. M. Lehus her husband of Baldwin in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Lydia Leib of Shawnee County Kansas of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said part III of the first part in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The North half of Lots One hundred and twenty two (122) One hundred and twenty four (124) One hundred and twenty six (126) One hundred and twenty eight (128) One hundred and thirty (130) and One hundred and thirty two (132) on Indiana Street, Baldwin City, Kansas, subject to a prior mortgage of \$800, given to the Loan Association of Lawrence, Kan. also Lot One (1) and 6th North West quarter of Section Seven (7) Twp. twenty two (22) Range 25 in Hodgeman County, State of Kansas, this subject to a Mortgage of \$450, given the Davidson Mortgage Co. of Wichita, Kansas.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part III of the first part therein. And the said

P. A. Lehus and R. M. Lehus do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances. Except the Mortgage heretofore mentioned, one for \$800 and one for \$450

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars Principal & Interest according to the terms of Two certain Promissory Notes this day executed and delivered by the said P. A. Lehus & R. M. Lehus to the said party of the second part: Notes in substance as follows. One Note for \$800 payable in One year from date, and One Note for \$450 payable in two years from date, both drawing 8% interest payable semi annually. Interest coupon notes attached bearing 10% but after maturity until paid.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her heirs executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part her heirs, executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said P. A. Lehus & R. M. Lehus heirs and assigns.
