I further agree and covenant to sell the said land unto the Plaintiff and his wife John E. Smith and Fermin Smith and he worded in book #28 of Mortgages, at page 535 in the office of the Register of Deeds of Douglas County, Kansas, this 11 day of May A. D. 1900.

This Indenture, Made this 98th day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety four, between
John E. Smith and his wife Fermin Smith
of in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas
of the first part, and Joseph Lewis
of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said partis of the first part in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South West fractional quarter of Section 18, Eighteen, The North half of the South East quarter of Section Eighteen 18/4 and West half of the rest thirty five acres of East half of South West quarter of Section 18, Eighteen 18/4 containing 73 1/4 acres more or less

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest, of the said partis of the first part therein. And the said John E. Smith
doth hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred Dollars payable four years after date with interest payable annually at the rate of Seven and one half per cent per annum, on one certain promissory note this day executed and delivered by the said John E. Smith and Fermin Smith to the said party of the second part; with privilege of paying on said note \$100 or any multiple thereof on principal when any annual interest is due

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said John E. Smith his heirs and assigns.
