This Indenture, Made this 16th day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety four, between Ebin Baldwin and Grace Baldwin his wife of Douglas in the County of Kansas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Mrs E. Mann and Archibald J. Mann of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the North East corner of the North East Quarter of Section sixteen, Township twelve, Range nineteen in said County & State, thence south sixteen and forty one hundredth chains to a stone three fourths seven and one four one hundredth chains to a tree three north twenty two degrees west six and thirty eight one hundredth chains, be an oak tree eleven north fifty five and one fourth degree, west six and thirty eight one hundredth chains to a hickory tree, thirteen north fifty eight and three fourth degree, west four and fifty five one hundredth chains to a steel fence north thirty three and one four fourths one and one half chains, thence north sixty seven and thirty four degree, west thirty and one half chains to a stake in the middle of last quarter section, thence north thirteen and one right one hundredth chains to the south west corner of said quarter section, thence east forty and twenty eight one hundredth chains to the place of beginning containing about four hundred and twenty five acres plus or minus, subject to such interest as may be given for taxes and expenses for public roads being the same from the day of recording with all the appurtenances, and for the estate, time and interest of the said party of the first part therein. do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof, he is the lawful owner— of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances—

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of-

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part John executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part John executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said John Baldwin his heirs and assigns.
