second part:

Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum  
of sixteen hundred  $\frac{8}{10}$  Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do  
by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second  
part, his heirs and assigns, all the following-described real estate, situated in  
Douglas County and State of Kansas, to wit: The East half of the North East quar-  
ter of Section Thirty (30) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty one (11) East, and the  
North East quarter of the North East quarter Section Twenty three (23) Township  
Thirteen (13) Range Twenty (20) East, containing One hundred and twenty (120)  
acres in all.

To Have and to Hold the same, Together with all and singular the tenements,  
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise ap-  
pertaining, forever.

Provided Always, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas,  
said Benjamin F. Foust and Emma Foust have this day executed and delivered  
one certain promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, of
