This Indenture, Made this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five between Theodore Poehler and Sophie Poehler husband and wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas of the first part, and August Poehler and Marie Poehler of the second part, witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9000<sup>00</sup>) Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to wit: Lots numbered Seventy three (73) Seventy five (75) Seventy seven (77) Seventy nine (79) and Eighty one (81) in the City of Lawrence and on Tennessee Street in the said City, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of the first part therein. And the said Theodore Poehler and Sophie Poehler man and wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Nine Thousand (\$9000<sup>00</sup>) Dollars, according to the terms of one certain Note this day executed by the said Theodore Poehler and Sophie Poehler to the said parties of the second part, payable ten years from the date hereof with interest at the rate of 15<sup>0</sup> per cent per annum payable annually.

And this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as is herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole shall be due and payable, and it shall be lawful for said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed
