Witnesseth, That the party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South east quarter of Section Eleven (11) in Township Fourteen (14) of Range Nineteen (19) with the appurtenances and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein.
And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances; that he has good right to sell and convey said premises, and that he will warrant and defend the same against the lawful claim of all persons.
