This Indenture, Made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of September 1895, by and between O. G. Markham and Socia B. Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the debt hereinafter mentioned, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the following described real estate situate in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to-wit: The South Twelve (12) feet of Lot Twenty Nine (29) and all of Lots Thirty (30) Thirty One (31) Thirty Two (32) and Thirty Three (33) on Sixth Street in Baldwin City, Douglas County, Kansas.

Also the following shares of stock in said Association, namely, Ten shares Certificate number 3703 of Class A

And the said O. G. Markham and Socia B. Markham do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner of the real estate above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, forever, against all persons claiming the same, hereby waiving and releasing to said party of the second part, all right, title, interest and estate in and to the above described premises resulting from or incident to the homestead laws of the State of Kansas.

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all and singular the rights, privileges, tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever, upon this condition, to-wit:
