Witnesseth, That the said parts of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Thirty five (\$135⁰⁰) Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Lot Number Six (6) in Block Twenty one (21) Missouri Street in W. J. Sinclair's addition to the City of Lawrence, with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said W. G. Houser & Gertrude B.
