

This Indenture, Made this Twelfth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety four, between O. N. Almondorph and Martha A. Almondorph his wife of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, of the first part, and Martha F. Foster of the State of Ohio, of the second part,

**Witnesseth**, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand five hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning forty <sup>40</sup> feet North of the Southwest corner of North East quarter section one in Township Number <sup>13</sup> Range <sup>11</sup> the West End of <sup>60</sup> feet North <sup>12</sup> chains East, thence <sup>12</sup> chains South, <sup>12</sup> chains, East <sup>12</sup> chains, South <sup>12</sup> chains, East <sup>12</sup> chains, South <sup>12</sup> chains, West <sup>12</sup> chains, thence <sup>12</sup> chains to place of beginning, containing <sup>30</sup> acres more or less, and embracing what is called and known as University Place Annex comprising Blocks seventeen <sup>(17)</sup> to Twenty two <sup>(22)</sup> inclusive, save and except only lot 9 of Block 17 which is 50x175 feet, being all of said Annex except said excepted lot, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said O. N. Almondorph and Martha A. Almondorph his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances of every nature and kind whatsoever.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

One Thousand five hundred dollars, according to the terms of One certain Commission Note, this day executed and delivered by the said Parties of the first part to the said party of the second part, payable five years after date with interest at 10% after maturity, the interest until matured or default is evidenced by coupons attached to said note.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part, executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns.
