That the said part ~~of~~ ^{to} of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS, to Him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath sold and by these presents do ~~to~~ grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The East 1/4 of the Northeast Quarter (N.W. 1/4) of section Thirty six (36) in township Turbin (3) South Range Twenty (20) East of the Ninth Principal Meridian.

and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part the executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part the executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Clara Harbour
