

This Indenture, Made this 26th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five between Thomas H. Kennedy and his wife Emma J. Kennedy of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Mary J. Lewis of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section Twenty six (26) in Township Thirteen (13) of Range Nineteen (19)

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parcel of the first part therein. And the said Thomas H. Kennedy do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of two hundred dollars and interest thereon according to the terms of One certain Note this day executed and delivered by the said Thomas H. Kennedy and Emma J. Kennedy to the said party of the second part: payable on or before three years after date to order of said Mary J. Lewis at office of Governor of Lawrence Kansas with interest at seven per cent per annum

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Thomas H. Kennedy heirs and assigns.
