Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South half of Lot No Nine (9) and all of Lots No Eleven (11) and Thirteen (13) all on Avenue Street in the City of Lawrence in said County, and State according to the plat of said City.

But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party... of the second part... her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party... of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party... making such sale on demand to the said Ida J. Luckenbach heirs and assigns.
