

This Indenture, Made this 14th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety five between William S. Sinclair and Katie E. Sinclair his wife of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and Mrs. Kate N. Field of same place of the second part,

**Witnesseth**, That the said part1st of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party... of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Twenty four 1/4 acres in the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter, South of the Kaw River, Five and one half 1/2 acres in the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter, South of the Kaw River, and fifty nine and one half 1/2 acres in the West Half of the South West Quarter East and South of the Kaw River, all in Section 17 in Township 22 North 13 South of Range 16 West, one 1/2 East of the 6th E.M. subject to the right of way of the Union, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad Company. Also except the following beginning at a section corner on East line of South West quarter of said Section 17, thence North 50 feet to North 1/2 Sec. 17, thence East 50 feet to East line of said Quarter Sec. 17, thence South 1/4 mile to place of beginning, thence East beginning at a point 200 feet North of North 1/2 Sec. 17, thence East 1/2 mile to East line of said Quarter, thence North 1/2 mile to North 1/2 Sec. 17, thence East 1/2 mile to East line of said Quarter, thence South 1/2 mile to beginning. with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part1st of the first part therein. And the said William S. Sinclair and Katie E. Sinclair his wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars according to the terms of a certain Mortgage Note this day executed and delivered by the said William S. Sinclair and Katie E. Sinclair his wife to the said party... of the second part: due in five years from date, with interest from date to maturity, or default, as evidenced by coupons attached to said note, and interest from maturity, or default in the payment of interest, until fully paid, at the rate of ten per cent per annum and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party... of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party... of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party... making such sale on demand to the said William S. Sinclair and Katie E. Sinclair or their heirs and assigns.
