This Indenture, made this first day of April 1897 between The
Pierson Milling Company, a corporation under the Laws of the
State of Kansas, of the City of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and
State of Kansas party of the first part, and Mrs Martha Gillette Bab-
cock of said county and State party of the second part.

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consid-
eration of the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars in hand paid the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these
presents does grant, bargain, sell and Mortgage to the said
party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever all those
tracts, pieces and parcels of land situated in the county of
Douglas and State of Kansas described as follows, to-wit:

Lots Numbers Two (2) Four (4) and Six (6) all on Massachusetts
Street and Lot Number Five (5) and the South one half of Lot Num-
ber Three (3) both on New Hampshire Street, All being in the

of this conveyance.
