This Indenture, Made this 5th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven between Melville A. Heath and Evalina Heath, his wife of Balmira, Township in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas of the first part and B. J. Sheldon of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Sixteen hundred Dollars, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, and described as follows to wit: The North East quarter of Section Thirty three (33), Township Fourteen (14) Range Twenty one (21) according to government survey with the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said Melville A. Heath & Evalina Heath do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all encumbrances.

This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Sixteen Hundred Dollars, according to the terms of a certain coupon note this day executed by the said parties of the first part, to the said party of the second part; bearing even date herewith and payable 5 years after date with privilege of paying \$500 at any interest payment after three years from date with interest at 8% as evidenced by 6 interest coupons
