Witnesseth, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Eighteen hundred AND 100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part of of
 the second part, the Douglas her heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in
 Douglas County, and State of Kansas, to-wit:

The west half (1/2) and the north east quarter (1/4) of the north
 west quarter (1/4) of section number Twenty (20) Township
 Thirteen (13) Range Twenty-one (21) County and State afore-
 said containing one hundred and twenty acres, more
 or less -

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever:-

Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this expressed condition, that whereas said

William Barty and Mary Barty
 have this day executed and delivered One certain promissory note in writing to said part of of the second part,
 of which the following is a copy: \$1800 Endorsed Kansas Mar
1-1902 On or before five years after date we promise
to pay to the order of Mary A. Brangan, eighteen hundred
Dollars, value received, with interest at six per cent, per
annum after date until paid. Interest payable annually.

Now, If said parties of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part of of the second part, her heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon, shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said part of of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises.
