

This Indenture, Made this 15 day of Sept A. D. 1893, between
Jacob H. Elwell, a single man
 of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the first part, and
Emile Henon
 of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One Hundred AND no DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do give by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part 2 of
 the second part, his heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in
 Douglas County, and State of Kansas, to-wit:—

Lot One Hundred sixty eight (168), one hundred seventy (170), one hundred seventy
two (172) on High Street and Lot one hundred ninety five (195) one hundred
ninety seven (197) and one hundred ninety nine (199) on Indian Street,
all in Hogans Addition to Baldwin City, Kansas.

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever:—

Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this expressed condition, that whereas said

Jacob H. Elwell
 has on this day executed and delivered one certain promissory note in writing to said part 2 of the second part,
 of which the following is a copy: On or before two and one half years after date
we promise to pay to the order of Emile Henon at the Baldwin
State Bank, Baldwin, Kansas, one hundred dollars for value received
with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from date pay-
able annually

Now, If said part 1 of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 2 of the second part, his heirs
 or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the
 terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force
 and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due,
 and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part
 thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon,
 shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said part 2 of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of
 said premises.
