

This Indenture, Made this 25 day of May 1906, A. D. 189, between
Jeremias Schlegel and Sophia Schlegel, his wife
 of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the first part, and
The State Bank of Eudora
 of Douglas County, in the State of Kansas of the second part:

Witnesseth, That said part ies of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Twenty nine hundred AND 00 DOLLARS,
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part y of
 the second part, its heirs and assigns, all the following described REAL ESTATE, situated in
 Douglas County, and State of Kansas, to-wit:—

The East three-quarters of the Northeast quarter of the
North East quarter of Section number Six (6) Township number
Thirteen (13) Range number twenty-one (21)
And the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter And
Lot #1 in Section number thirty-one, Township number
twelve (12) Range number twenty-one (21).

To Have and to Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever:—

Provided, Always, And these presents are upon this expressed condition, that whereas said

Jeremias Schlegel and Sophia Schlegel
 ha at this day executed and delivered their certain promissory note in writing to said part y of the second part,
 of which the following is a copy: \$2900.00 Eudora, Kansas, May 1906,

One year after date, for value received, we, or either of us, promise
to pay to the order of the State Bank of Eudora, Twenty nine
hundred Dollars, At the State Bank of Eudora, Eudora, Kansas,
with interest at the rate of Six per cent per annum, payable
annually from date.

Privilege granted to pay \$100.00 or multiples thereof at any time
and stop interest on the amounts so paid.

Now, If said part ies of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part y of the second part, its heirs
 or assigns, said sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the
 terms and tenor of the same, then these presents shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force
 and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid, when the same is due,
 and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part
 thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, then the whole of said sum and sums, and interest thereon,
 shall, and by these presents become due and payable, and said part y of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of
 said premises.
