This Indenture, Made this First day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety six, Witnesseth, that J. B. Watkins, unmarried, of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, party of the first part, for and in consideration of Fifty Thousand Dollars, conveys and warrants to Edwin C. Walker party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, the real estate hereinafter described, situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, to wit: Lots numbered One Hundred and Eleven (111) One Hundred and Thirteen (113) and One Hundred and Fifteen (115) on Massachusetts Street in the City of Lawrence in said County and State according to the plat of said City.

To secure the said party of the second part for an actual loan of money made to the said J. B. Watkins, as evidenced by a series of ten certain promissory notes, numbered 20583, 20584, 20585, 20586, 20587, 20588, 20589, 20590, 20591 and 20592 and aggregating the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars, of even date herewith, in and by which said notes the party of the first part promises to pay to the order of Edwin C. Walker in lawful money of the United States of America, the principal sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars, payable in ten payments of \$5000 each year, for ten years after date thereof, with interest thereon at the rate of six
