This indenture made this 28th day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety Eight between Edward W. Olmstead (single) of Clearfield in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, of the first part, and W. B. Fullerton of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred ^{no} Dollars to him duly paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas and described as follows to wit, The West half (W¹/₂) of Sixty five (65) acres, of the South Side of the South half (S¹/₂) of the South East quarter (S.E. 1/4) of Section Nineteen (19) Township Thirteen (14) Range Twenty one (21) Subject to the conditions of a deed executed the 21st day of Feby. 1898, with the appurtenances and all the estate title and interest of the said party of the first part therein, and the said Edward W. Olmstead does hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof he is the lawful owner of the premises above granted and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all encumbrances. This Grant is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars according to the terms of a certain note this day executed by the said party of the first part to the said party of the second part, and this conveyance shall be void if such payment be made as herein specified.
