This Indenture made the first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight between George F. Bick and Anna Maria Bick his wife, of the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, Parties of the first part, and The Northwestern Mutual Life Insurance Company, party of the second part: Witnesseth That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred (2500) Dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns forever, the following real estate, lying and being in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, and Union and described as follows, viz. All that part of the Southwest quarter of Section Number Twelve (12) Township Number Twelve (12) South, Range Number Nineteen (19) East, bounded and described as follows, viz. Commencing at a point on the West line of said Southwest quarter, eighteen and sixty eight one hundredths (18⁶⁸/₁₀₀) rods south of the Northwest corner thereof, thence running south on said West line to the Southwest corner of said quarter section, thence east eighty (80) rods, thence North eighty (80) rods, thence east eighty (80) rods, to the East line of said quarter section, thence North on said East line to a point eighteen and sixty eight one hundredths (18⁶⁸/₁₀₀) rods South of the Northeast corner thereof, thence West to the place of beginning subject to a perpetual right of way over upon and across said lands upon a strip twenty (20) feet in width on the West side thereof running from North to South as reserved in the deed from Sylvester S. Zimmerman and wife and Edwin Zimmerman to Henry M. Simpson, dated January 4, 1865, recorded in Book 5
