This Indenture made this Twenty Eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine, Witnesseth that May E. Hoss and her husband George W. Hoss, of the County of Sedgwick, and State of Kansas, party of the first part, for and in consideration of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars, conveyed and Warrants to B. B. Power, party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, the real estate hereinafter described, situated in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas to wit: Lots Eighty Four (84), Eighty Five (85) and Ten Feet of the East half of Lot Eighty Six (86), all on Dearborn Street in the City of Baldwin, in said County and State. To secure the said party of the second part for an actual loan of money made to the said May E. Hoss and George W. Hoss, as evidenced by a certain Bond No. 662, and aggregating the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, of date Jan. 28th 1899, in and by which said Bond the party of the first part promise to pay to the order of B. B. Power, in lawful money of the United States of America, the principal sum of Five Hundred Dollars, Five years after date thereof with interest thereon at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum, interest payable semi-annually, according to and upon presentation of interest coupons therefor therunto attached, both principal and interest being payable at the Watkins National Bank of Lawrence, Kansas. Also Providing That in case any interest on any of said sums shall remain unpaid for ten days after the same becomes due, then the entire sums covered by said bond and secured by this Mortgage Deed to become immediately due and payable, without any notice of any kind whatsoever, and same to be collected in like manner as if the full time provided in said bond had expired. It is hereby Expressly Agreed, That said first party shall insure the buildings that are insurable
