

In consideration of the payment to it of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, The Union Central Life Insurance Company, hereby releases from the lien of a certain mortgage made to it by Gabriel Marchle (widower), date February 15, 1899, calling for \$500.00 and recorded in book 35 page 374 of the Records of Douglas County, State of Kansas, the following described real estate, which is included in said mortgage, viz: 6 acres in the S.W. corner and 3 acres in the S.E. corner, being all of the land south of the Wakarusa river in the W¹/₂ of the N.E. ¹/₄ of section 11, Township No. 15 South of Range No. 17 East of the 6th P.M., containing 9 acres, more or less, situated in Douglas County, State of Kansas, It being expressly agreed between the parties hereto that this release is in no way to operate to discharge the lien of said mortgage from any other of the premises described therein, and that the remaining portions of the premises in said mortgage described, are to remain as security for the payment of the indebtedness secured thereby. This release is made only upon the express condition precedent that no other lien has attached to the remaining part of said mortgaged premises, or any part thereof, since the date of the said mortgage except a mortgage from Paul Hochler and Bertha Hochler, his wife, to Gabriel Marchle, recorded in Book 40, page 427 of the mortgage records of Douglas County, Kansas, and that no interest, legal or equitable, has been acquired in any part of said mortgaged premises since the date of said mortgage, except a bond for deed from Gabriel Marchle to Paul Hochler, recorded in Book 69, page 458, and a deed from Gabriel Marchle to Paul Hochler recorded in Book 74, page 81, of the Deed records of Douglas County, Kansas. If any such interest has been acquired therein, except as above, then this release shall not take effect. The object of this stipulation is, that the release of said portion of said mortgaged premises shall not imperil or in any way affect the interest of said mortgagee in the remainder of said premises.
