

This Indenture, Made this 28th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety six between Elizabeth Studebaker widow of Daniel Studebaker deceased and Clara A. Maple (formerly Clara A. Trub, widow of Joseph A. Trub deceased) and Louis of the first part, and William T. Daniels, of Lawrence, Kansas of the second part,

Witnesseth. That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The North Sixty (60) acres of the North East Quarter of Section Number Six, in Township Number Ten (10) South of Range No. Eighteen (18) East of the Meridian, Real the South East Quarter of Section Number One (1) in Township Number Fourteen (14) South of Range No. Eighteen (18) East of the Meridian, Beginning at a point thirteen (13) rods East of a point forty (40) rods South of the Northeast corner of said claim and running thence easterly until it intersects a line running with the line of Section Number Six (6) Road East of the Westline of said Quarter Section, thence Northwesterly to the Northwest corner of said Quarter Section, thence East One hundred (100) rods to the North East corner of said Quarter Section, thence about thirty five (35) rods thence West, so that the line South (9) rods, thence West One hundred (100) rods to a point beginning at the point of intersection of the line South (9) rods, thence Northwesterly to the Northwest corner of said Quarter Section, thence about three hundred (300) rods to the North East corner of said Quarter Section, thence about

parties of the first part

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof, we are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, against all persons lawfully claiming the same.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of

twelve hundred dollars

according to the terms of one certain Mortgage Note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part due in five (5) years from date, with interest from date to maturity or default as evidenced by coupon attached to said note, and interest after maturity or default at the rate of ten percent per annum, until fully paid.

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
