

This Indenture, Made this 4th day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, between Simpson Hollister and Mary Hollister his wife of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and D. S. Alford of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South Half (1/2) of the Northwest Fractional quarter (N.W. Fr 1/4) of Section Nineteen (19) in Township Twelve (12) of Range Twenty (20) Excepting therefrom the right of way of the Union Pacific Railway Company.

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part

do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner(s) of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances.

Except one Mortgage for \$650 and that the title is in Controversy in Sup Court

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Three hundred Dollars, due in six months from May 4th 1897, according to the terms of One certain Note this day executed and delivered by the said Simpson Hollister to the said party of the second part:

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said Simpson Hollister his heirs and assigns.
