

This Indenture, Made this 14th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight, between Maggie A. Woodward, of the City of Lawrence, in the County of Douglas, and State of Kansas, widow of the first part, and Hugh Blair, of the second part,

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS, to her duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath sold and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 13, on west line of said quarter section & running thence northerly along said line and thence westwardly along the middle of the channel of said creek, thence northerly along middle of channel of said creek about 17 chains south of the north line of said quarter section, thence east to about 13 1/2 chains east of the east line of said quarter section, thence south to the south line of said quarter section, thence west 13 1/2 chains bearing also right of way across said creek south to the south line of the south east corner of Section 13, thence returning southwesterly along said line and thence west to the place of beginning containing acres, all beginning and ending at the south east corner of Section 13, having 13 1/2 acres West of the Section line, and so to North West corner of the northeast corner of said section, thence South 1/2 way thence East 1/2 rods thence North East corner thereof or curve to place of beginning so as to contain 5 1/3 acres, and it is understood and hereby recited that the three (3) parcels of land hereby conveyed and mortgaged contain by admeasurement in the aggregate (13 1/2) Sixty six 1/2 acres, with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said party of the first part therein. And the said Maggie A. Woodward doth hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof she is the lawful owner of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances of every nature kind.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of One Thousand Dollars.

according to the terms of One certain Real Estate Mortgage Note this day executed and delivered by the said Party of the first part to the said party of the second part: Payable five years after date with interest at seven percent semi-annually according to coupons attached to said note and with privilege of paying \$100 or any multiple thereof on account Principal Money at time of paying interest

and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part, their executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said party of the first part, her heirs and assigns.
