

This Indenture, Made this Thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven between Mary G. Bruce, a widow of Jefferson Co. Kansas, also O.W. Murphy and Carrie Murphy, widow of Lawrence of \_\_\_\_\_ in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and William J. Sinclair, of Lawrence, Kansas of the second part.

**Witnesseth**, That the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Twenty Four Hundred (\$2400) DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said party of the second part, heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Jefferson and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South East Quarter of Section No. Twenty-one (1) in Township No. Eleven (11) South Range No. Nineteen (19) East of the Principal Meridian containing acres more or less. Also all that certain other piece of land situated in the County of Douglas, State of Kansas and described as the Nine (9) in Block the Eighth (8), and also an addition to the City of Lawrence, but last described property being the homestead of the said O.W. Murphy and wife, said Mary G. Bruce hereby agrees to maintain insurance on the buildings situated on said first described property to the amount of one thousand dollars and said O.W. Murphy hereby agrees to maintain insurance on the buildings situated on said last described property to the amount of one thousand dollars the policies to be acceptable to second party or his assigns. To remain with the owner of this property with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the said parties of the first part do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they will affix their true names of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances and that they will warrant and defend the same in the quiet and peaceable possession of second party his heirs and assigns forever against all persons lawfully claiming the same.

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty four hundred Dollars according to the terms of their certain mortgage note this day executed and delivered by the said parties of the first part to the said party of the second part; due in five (5) years from date with interest from date to maturity or default as evidenced by coupons attached to said note and interest after maturity or default at the rate of one percent per annum until fully paid in such event the sheriff's deed to said property together with the possession thereof and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said party of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns.
