

This Indenture, Made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety Eight between George Hordl and Caroline his wife of Lexington in the County of Johnson and State of Kansas of the first part, and Christian Thomsen of the second part.

**Witnesseth**, That the said part of of the first part in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha<sup>ve</sup> sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of of the second part his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Fourteen "14" Township Thirteen "13" Range Twenty "20" also the North 30 acres of the S.E. 1/4 of N.W. 1/4 (N. of Captain Creek) in Sec. 14, Town 13, Range 21 also that tract or parcel of land situated in Douglas County Kansas and described as follows commencing at the S.E. corner of the N.E. 1/4 of section 18, Town 13, Range 21 thence North 31 1/2° West 14 1/2° chains thence N. 31 1/2° West 5<sup>00</sup> chains thence N. 40 1/2° East 3<sup>00</sup> chains thence N. 60° East 2<sup>30</sup> chains thence East on 1/4 section line 11 1/4 chains to section line thence South on section line 80 rods to place of beginning containing 11 acres more or less with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part is of the first part therein. And the said George Hordl and wife do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owner<sup>s</sup> of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fourteen Hundred Dollars

according to the terms of One certain Note this day executed and delivered by the said George Hordl and wife to the said part of of the second part of which the following is a copy: 1400<sup>00</sup> Budora Mo. Feb. 16 1898. Six years after date its promise to pay to the order of Christian Thomsen Fourteen Hundred Dollars with 7% int payable annually. Geo. Hordl, Caroline Hordl and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part therefor, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of of the second part his executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisement hereby waived or not at the option of the part of of the second part his executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the part of making such sale on demand to the said George Hordl and wife their heirs and assigns.
