

This Indenture, Made this 30th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety eight between Sarah J. McBride and Bernatt J. McBride her husband of _____ in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas of the first part, and R. Allen Hill of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said part of of the first part in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred DOLLARS, to them duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, ha ve sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and mortgage to the said part of of the second part her heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Douglas and State of Kansas, described as follows, to-wit: The South half of the South West quarter and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section Twenty (20) Township Thirteen (13) Range Twenty One (21) East of 6th P.M. Containing One hundred & Twenty (120) acres

with all the appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest of the said part of of the first part therein. And the said Sarah J. McBride and Bernatt J. McBride do hereby covenant and agree that at the delivery hereof they are the lawful owners of the premises above granted, and seized of a good and indefeasible estate of inheritance therein free and clear of all incumbrances

This grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars and the interest thereon according to the terms of One certain Promissory Note this day executed and delivered by the said Sarah J. McBride and Bernatt J. McBride to the said part of of the second part: Copy of Note - Cudora, Kansas, June 30th 1898, \$500 - thirty years after date I promise to pay the order of R. Allen Hill Fifteen Hundred Dollars with seven per cent interest per annum from date until paid interest payable semi-annually. Signed Sarah J. McBride Bernatt J. McBride and this conveyance shall be void if such payments be made as herein specified. But if default be made in such payment, or any part thereof, or interest thereon, or the taxes, or if the insurance is not kept up thereon, then this conveyance shall become absolute, and the whole amount shall become due and payable, and it shall be lawful for the said part of of the second part her executors, administrators and assigns, at any time thereafter, to sell the premises hereby granted, or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, appraisal hereby waived or not at the option of the party of the second part her executors, administrators or assigns; and out of all the moneys arising from such sales, to retain the amount then due for principal and interest, together with the costs and charges for making such sales, and the overplus, if any there be, shall be paid by the party of making such sale on demand to the said Parties of the first part or their heirs and assigns.
