An Indenture, dated the first day of July, A.D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven, by and between Union Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation organized, and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Utah (hereinafter called the "Railroad Company"), party of the first part; and the Mercantile Trust Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New York, and having its office in the City of New York (hereinafter called the "Trustee"), party of the second part. Whereas, the Railroad Company was formed on or about the first day of July, 1897, under and in pursuance of an Act of the legislature of the State of Utah, entitled "An Act to provide for the formation of railroad corporations for the purpose of purchasing, owning, maintaining, operating and extending railroad lines, franchises, properties and appurtenances, authorizing the issue of Bonds, making deeds of trust and mortgages, and defining the rights, and powers of such corporations."
